Amazon River Church Construction Trip Information

Team: South Texas District Men's Team Trip Dates: June 2-9, 2018 Team Leader: Manny Martinez Host Missionary: Mark Lemos Trip Coordinator: Betsy Martin, Builders International

LODGING AND MEALS

- 1. Lodging in Manuas. The team will stay in a 3-star hotel the first two nights in Manaus. The hotel amenities include free wifi and internet access, room service and a pool. (Any charges made by team members at the hotel that are NOT covered in the trip cost must be paid upon check-out the next day.)
- 2. Lodging on the river. For the remainder of the trip, the team will be staying on an all-inclusive river boat. Most sleeping rooms are double occupancy and contain bunk beds. The rooms are just big enough to hold the bunk beds and have a bit of space for luggage.
- 3. There will be 3 boat crew and 3 cooks/housekeeping staff onboard to take care of the team
- 4. Each sleeping room has a window A/C unit.
- 5. There is ONE bathroom on the boat for the team to share. It is about the size of a phone booth. The shower does not have hot water.
- 6. Laundry service will be provided by the boat. There is no charge for this service, however, plan on providing a tip for the housekeeping staff.
- 7. There is no wifi or internet access on the riverboat.
- 8. There is 110 voltage electricity.
- 9. All meals while staying along the river will be cooked on the boat by the staff. Meals may consist of rice, beans, noodles, fish, and beef. Plenty of water and soda will also be provided.
- 10. The team will get to enjoy an authentic Brazilian steak dinner in Manaus on the last day.

MINISTRY

The team will be building a church for the local community. The work will take place in one of the many communities that are located right along the Amazon River. The work will include putting up columns, trusses, roofing, and laying block walls.

Additional ministry opportunities:

There will be opportunities to interact with the local people during the trip. Team members who aren't actively engaged with the church construction can minister to children, help paint the local pastor's house, or teach any skill that can be taught in 3 days. One example is a team that built pews for the church. Providing water filters to families in the community is another option.



FREE TIME

There will be time each day for rest and relaxation, as well as lots of time to fellowship with the people in the community. Free time activities could include swimming with dolphins, fishing, swimming in the Amazon, exploring the jungle and riverbanks, and just relaxing in one of the hammocks on the boat. If you want to fish, you will need to pack your own fishing gear.

VACCINATIONS

Required: Yellow Fever. *At this time, there is no vaccine available. The company that produces the vaccine hopes to have it available sometime during the summer of 2018.* The cost for the vaccination *may* be covered by your health insurance provider.

Recommended: Malaria and Tetanus. Please visit the Centers for Disease Control for more health information for travelers to Brazil at: https://wwwnc.cdc.gov/travel/destinations/traveler/none/brazil.

PASSPORT

Team members are required to have a U.S. Passport to travel outside of the United States. Please apply for or renew your passport if:

- 1. You do not have a passport
- 2. Your passport will expire on or before December 10, 2018
- 3. You do not have any blank visa pages left (a partial page WILL NOT work)

All team members MUST have a valid passport by February 15, 2018.

TOURIST VISA

A Tourist Visa is required to enter Brazil and must be applied for in advance of the trip. *The Builders International Trip Coordinator will work with the team members to get all the required documentation ready for submission.*

Visa Requirements:

- 1. Valid U.S. passport.
- 2. Professional color passport-style photo, taken within the last 6 months.
- 3. Confirmation of round-trip booking. Builders International will provide this.
- 4. Clear copy of driver's license or state-issued ID. (Address on driver's license must match the address used on the visa application.)
- 5. Proof of sufficient funds to support your stay.
- 6. Complete and sign the Sworn Statement waiver.
- 7. Minors (under age 18) must provide a Travel Authorization for Minors Form.
- 8. Completed Brazilian Online Visa Application Form.

All team members MUST have all visa requirements ready for submission by March 1, 2018.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INSURANCE AGREEMENT

AGWM Personnel and Member Care

In consideration of my acceptance as a short-term volunteer with Assemblies of God World Missions of The General Council of the Assemblies of God U.S.A., I represent and agree that:

- 1. I am a volunteer worker and acknowledge that I am not an employee of Assemblies of God World Missions or The General Council of the Assemblies of God U.S.A.
- 2. I am aware of the hazards and risks to my person and property associated with serving in a missions capacity, such hazards and risks including, but not being limited to, injury, increased stress, accident, disease, inadequate medical services and supplies, death, criminal acts— including terrorism—natural disasters, government action, and relocation due to any of the above. I accept my assignment with full awareness of these risks, and subject to the insurance coverage described in the AOG GTL insurance brochure, I voluntarily assume all risks of death, injury, illness, and damage to myself or any member of my family associated with such risks and any damage to my personal property. I further recognize that such risks have always been associated with missionary service (2 Corinthians 11:23-28).
- 3. I attest and certify that I have no medical conditions that would prevent me from performing my duties.
- 4. Subject to the insurance coverage described in the AOG GTL insurance brochure, I waive and release any and all claims for damages which I or my heirs or successors may have against Assemblies of God World Missions, The General Council of the Assemblies of God, any district council of the Assemblies of God, the local church sponsoring the trip, or any agent or employee of any of such organizations, arising from my death, injury, or illness, or any property damage or loss occurring during the term of my assignment or as a result of my assignment.
- 5. In the event I have minor children who will accompany me on my assignment, I, acting both on my own behalf and on their behalf as their parent and legal guardian and subject to the insurance coverage described in the AOG GTL insurance brochure, do hereby assume all risks of death, illness, or injury that they may suffer as a result of said assignment, from those causes described above.
- 6. I understand and accept the following policy of Assemblies of God World Missions regarding ransom payments:

The Assemblies of God World Missions Executive Committee has determined that it will not pay ransom nor yield to the demands of anyone who takes one of our missionary family or staff hostage. The Assemblies of God World Missions pledges itself to every effort in prayer and all other appropriate means to obtain the release of one taken hostage, should it ever occur. This policy was made after sufficient study of the policies of other evangelical missionary societies and after considering the advice of the United States State Department.

- 7. I expressly waive any defense to the enforcement of any provisions of this commitment arising from a claim of lack of consideration and warrant that this commitment constitutes a legal, valid, and binding obligation upon me enforceable against me in accordance with its terms.
- 8. I expressly agree that this assumption of risk and indemnity agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by law.



CODE OF CONDUCT

"Let us therefore make every effort to do what leads to peace and to mutual edification." Romans 14:19 NIV

As a follower of the Lord Jesus, our conduct should be a witness to others of a transformed life. Paul wrote to Titus,

And show your own self in all respects to be a pattern and **a model of good deeds and works**, teaching what is unadulterated, showing gravity [having the strictest regard for truth and purity of motive], with dignity and seriousness. And let your instruction be sound and fit and wise and wholesome, vigorous and irrefutable and above censure, so that the opponent may be put to shame, finding nothing discrediting or evil to say about us." - In respect to this assignment, I will refrain from anything (e.g., alcohol, tobacco, unwholesome speech) that may distract from my Christian testimony, cause division, or demonstrate disrespect to the national church, missionary personnel, my team, or the Assemblies of God.
- I promise to forgo my personal convictions on these subjects in order to maintain unity and to avoid controversy in the body of Christ.
- I affirm that I do not have any criminal convictions or allegations related to sexual misconduct with an adult or minor, nor do I know of any reason I should not be allowed to work with adults or minors as a short-term missions volunteer.
